Special Pre-Teen and Teen Programs

Grades 7 - 12

Girls Promoting Safety (GPS) Program: A violence prevention program for middle school girls designed to prepare girls to avoid being victims of violence and to break the fear and isolation of girls who are being hurt. Funded in part by the Women's Initiative of the United Way of Central Massachusetts. *Contact your child's middle school on how to get involved.*

Girls Inc. Friendly PEERSuasion[®]: This program helps girls develop the skills to resist pressure to use harmful substances, such as drugs, tobacco and alcohol. After learning healthy ways to manage stress and to deflect peer, media, and other pressures, the girls become peer educators for younger girls.

Fall Swim Lessons Begin Monday, September 12

The Girls Inc. Fuller Aquatics Center offers American Red Cross swim lessons for all ages: parents and babies, children, adults, and seniors!



Learn-To-Swim Program: (Ages 6 and up) Classes are designed to help participants of all ages. Learn-To-Swim is based on a six-level progression system allowing swimmers to develop their swimming and survival skills, along with water safety.

Parent and Child Swim: (Ages 6 months-3 years) Parents and children learn together to increase child's comfort level in the water and build a foundation of basic skills. This level adds a fun twist to introducing water safety concepts.

Beginner Level: (Ages 4-5) Children are taught basic water safety and survival skills. Focusing on gaining greater independence and comfort in and around water environments:

- Level 1- Introduction to Water Skills
- Level 2- Fundamental Water Skills
- Level 3- Stroke Development
- Level 4: Stroke Improvement
