## In-Town Summer Fun Program for Girls grades K-8

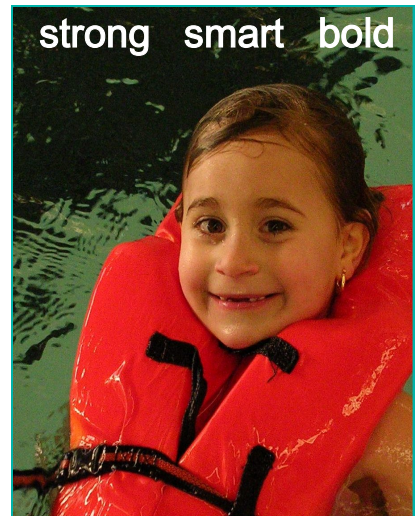
