Sustained Exposure

We know that sustained exposure to programming over time increases positive outcomes and reduces the potential for negative outcomes. For older girls, like Adwoa, who has been a Girls Inc. member since she was in 4th grade, we measure the progress over a period of years. In 2012, with sustained support from Girls Inc. - including homework help, mentors, advancement to become a volunteer and then staff member - Adwoa was one of ten Girls Inc. National Scholars to receive a \$15,000 scholarship to attend Emmanuel College. After completing her first year at college, Adwoa returned to Girls Inc. this summer to contribute as a staff member and help foster positive outcomes for other girls.
