This was a dynamic year for Girls Incorporated of Worcester to collaborate with community leaders for action-oriented reflection of our mission and to chart our course for growth for the next century. While our Board of Directors focused on the strategic direction and building the groundwork for growth and sustainability, our staff empowered more than 1,400 girls and families with life-changing experiences and real solutions to the unique issues girls face.

This Annual Report focuses on the community impact of the Essential Elements of the Girls Inc. Experience – a holistic, in-depth approach that combines mentorship, programming, and a positive all-girl environment. At Girls Inc., girls have learned to set and achieve goals, boldly confront challenges, resist peer pressure, see college as attainable, and explore nontraditional fields such as STEM (science, technology, engineering, math).

Some of our key accomplishments this year include:

- Serving over 25% more girls with impact in after-school and summer programs.
- Placing over 20 high school girls in summer externships for job shadowing opportunities at community organizations.
- Investing in our staff through retirement programs, leadership training, and a performance management system.
- Demonstrating fiscal responsibility with a balanced budget.
- Honoring over 40 graduating high school seniors at our annual College Shower.
- Being recognized with the New England Regional Assembly Recognition Award by College Board and the Non-Profit of the Year in Central Massachusetts by GoLocal Worcester.

This work cannot be done alone. We are honored to work with a dedicated Board of Directors, staff, volunteers, and community supporters. Together, we are all champions for girls with power to change girls' lives and thereby transform families, communities, and our collective futures.

Sustained Exposure

We know that sustained exposure to programming and connection with a girl over time increases positive outcomes and reduces the potential for negative outcomes.

For Paris, a 9th grader who has been a Girls Inc. girl since she was in kindergarten, we measure progress over a period of years. She has been involved in almost all the Girls Inc. signature programs and is most recently in her 3rd year in Eureka!, our unique 5 year STEM (science, technology, engineering and math), Sports, and Leadership program that will follow girls from 8th grade to high school graduation.



Revenue Year Ending June 2014






