



## Summer Program Policies/Information

**Sign In/Sign Out:** Students will sign themselves in and out each day.

**Immunization Form:** A current and up-to-date immunization form must be completed before your child can attend camp.

**Medical History Form:** A current and up-to-date medical history form must be completed before your child can attend camp.

**Authorization to Administer Medications (if needed):** A current and up-to-date medical release form must be completed in order for Girls Inc. staff members to administer any medications to your child.

**What to wear:** Please send your child in clothing that is appropriate for all weather and play conditions: shorts or pants, sneakers or shoes with socks (NO Sandals please), sweatshirt or light jacket.

**What to bring:** Please send your child with a bathing suit, towel, plastic bag for wet items, a hat, sunscreen and bug spray.

**What not to bring:** Please do not send your child with any valuables or toys from home. Girls Inc. is not responsible for lost items.

**Lunch:** A bagged lunch and snack are provided each day. You may also choose to provide your own nutritious lunch and snack. NO glass bottles. Due to allergies please avoid packing nut products.

**Lost & Found:** Please put your child's name on everything. We often see duplicate bathing suits, towels, etc. Unclaimed items will be kept at the Providence Street location for the summer and then donated to a local homeless shelter in September.
